# Egyptian Gold Medals in Continental and International Championships

With an outstanding performance and determination, Ramadan Darwish, an Egyptian Judo player, has won the Montreal Grand Prix- Canada championship 2019.

Having the same fighting spirit, Hassan Hassan, a champion in Romanian Wrestling, has attained a golden medal in the African championship in Tunisia.

Layla Shoukry, the exemplary female athlete, has surpassed all limitations by winning first place gold medal in the African championship in Algeria.

Cairo 11 July 2019 – Egypt's champions have made an international breakthrough by winning plenty of titles and golden medals, elevating the country's image and statue in the world of Judo, Roman wrestling and Tennis. It's worth mentioning that Ramdan Darwish won the gold medal in the Grand prix Judo championship, held in Montreal this month. Darwish is ranked the sixth in the world and the fourth in the Olympic Judo Category.

Adding to our pride Hassan Hassan, Egypt's champion in Romanian Wrestling, has won the first place and the gold medal in the African championship that was held in Tunisia last April. Finally, the heroine Layla Shoukry went the extra mile and managed to win a gold medal, first place, in the African Tennis championship that was held in Algeria last June. Not only that, but because of her determination, she had a significant role in helping the national team win.

Ramadan Darwish has smashed the international Judo record, by becoming the champion of the Mediterranean tournament for three consecutive rounds. Darwish also won the African Judo Championship six times and reached the seventh place in the 2016 Rio de Janeiro Olympics.

One of Hassan's latest achievement, is winning the gold medal in African Championship - Tunisia in the weight of 72 kg in 2019. He also received a silver medal at the World Youth Championship in Slovakia, in September 2018. Hassan maintained his performance and position as the first place on Africa for eight times and fifth place zin the world championship for adults and finally Second place in the World Youth Championship.

The leading female athlete Layla Shoukry went the extra mile and managed to win a gold medal, first place, in the African Championship in Algeria last June. She has also won several individual and group Tennis tournaments. With much persistence and determination, Shoukry was given the second place in Egypt and Africa 2019 tournaments and the first in 2018.

Shoukry always had unprecedented performance in many local and international tournaments in the last period and is still working very hard to represent Egypt in the Roland Garros 2021 and the 2022 Youth Olympics. Her latest achievement was winning the African Championship and getting qualified for the World Cup.
